

Each year, Holstein Canada recognizes and awards students who are well-rounded in their farm involvement; work experience; youth program involvement; future career choices; and excel in their academic studies. 6 successful students across Canada (one student from the west; two from Ontario; two from Québec; and one from Atlantic Canada) will be awarded \$1,000 each for being recognized for their achievements.

Rules

- 1. Must be a regular or junior member of Holstein Canada, or a son/daughter of a member; or a member-farm employee that is supported by their employer.
- 2. Must have completed at least one year of university/college (or Cégep in Québec);
- 3. Must be returning to school within the calendar year;
- 4. Must complete and submit the following items in the application package:
 - Application form (please complete the form below)
 - Official, original transcript (faxed and photocopied transcripts will not be accepted)
 - Copy of resume
 - Letter of reference
 - A video or written essay on the following topic; Why do you see value in a Holstein Canada membership? What can Holstein Canada do to continue to show value?
