Considered the highest honour of the Association, Patty will be recognized as the 20<sup>th</sup> recipient of the Certificate in Superior Accomplishment given by Holstein Canada. This award is presented to successful candidates who display outstanding business achievements, mentorship, leadership, and promotion of the Holstein breed and/or Association programs.

Patty Jones, originally from the Eastern Townships of Qc, co-founded *Canadian Livestock Photography Inc.* in 1981 and has been a tremendous force within the Canadian dairy industry ever since. In her over 40 years of experience as a professional livestock photographer and successful business owner, Patty has become a well-known ambassador for the dairy industry both in Canada and abroad. Her encouragement of using photographs as a marketing tool to develop and enhance a farmer's advertising program has changed the way dairy cattle are

marketed across Canada and around the world.

Patty's reputation precedes her as her skills are continually sought after—more than 60,000 photographs have been taken by Patty in her lifetime and she continues to photograph anywhere from 1,800 to 2,500 cattle a year. Patty also owns and markets animals under the *Silvercap* prefix.

## Guest Speaker at Annual General Meeting: Tom Byers, Holstein Canada Head Classifer

In his role, he has identified the strengths and weaknesses of animals to help producers use corrective mating to ensure the advancement and progression of dairy breeds. Tom has been a relentless

Over the past 30 years, Tom has classified more than 300,000 cows and has experienced many changes as the classification system has evolved. The job and breed have certainly changed over the past 30 years, but Tom's humour, larger-than-life personality, his knack for storytelling, and the undeniable passion he has for the Holstein cow and classification program certainly have not!
