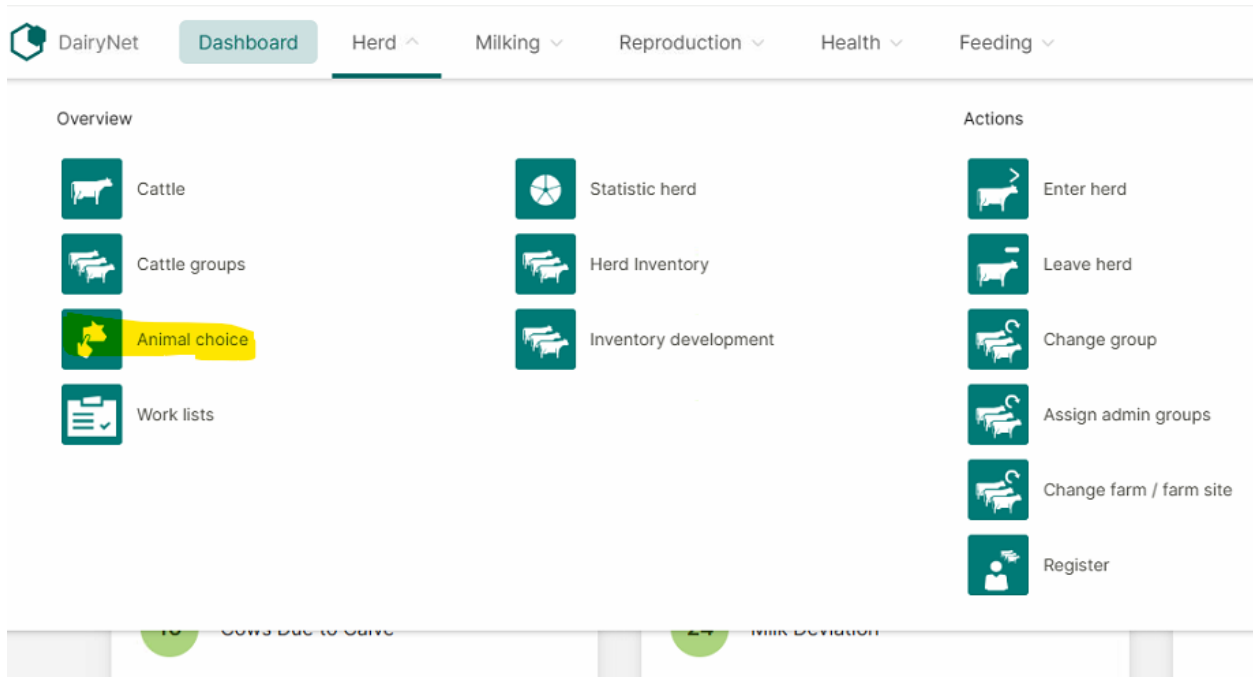
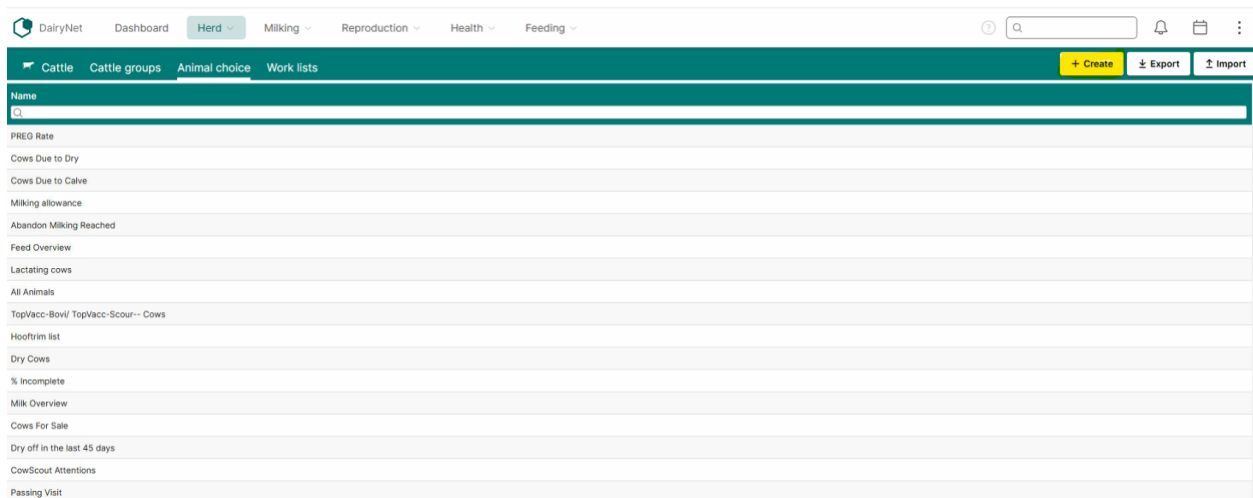




1. From the DairyNet dashboard select the “Herd” tab then “Animal Choice”
