Production Certificates

If you would like your animals considered for the production awards, please be sure to provide production information to the Holstein Canada Staff. This information can be shared at the time of animal check-in or handed to any HC Staff. The information must be received no later then Wednesday, November 9th at 12pm.

Holstein Canada Booth & Staff

The Holstein Canada Booth is beside the Ring of Excellence but will not be manned this year by staff. Holstein Canada staff will be available throughout the barns the whole week to help with:

- Replacing lost tags
- Transferring animals
- Signing up for web-account and e-docs

HC will also have a team member (Alison Karn) at the table at ringside for any last minute transfers required.

No Smoking & Alcohol

Please refrain from smoking in the barns. This is a no smoking facility. Smoking areas can be found on the exterior of the building outside any door. Thank you in advance!

It is a privilege the Exhibition place allows us to consume alcohol in their facilities. Please, keep all drinks in RED PLASTIC CUPS. No glass bottles at anytime will be permitted.

Ethic Rules – Friendly Reminder

- Performing alterations of any kind to change the visual appearance of an animal is **not permitted**, except the painting of spots smaller than **six (6) inches** in dimension on one side;
- Electro-stimulator machines (Dairy-Cell) will be permitted up to 12 hours before the start of the first class. For shows in Quebec, elector-stimulator machines (Dairy-Cell) are strictly prohibited;
- Ultrasound Examination: Placings 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 7th and 9th in All Milk Classes will be required to report to the ultrasound station prior to being milked out;
- 4. Syringes: Please keep all syringes guarded and boxed prior to use and dispose of them correctly in yellow sharp containers after use. Please be aware of the public around you when using syringes.
