proAction[®] Traceability 101: Tag Retention

There are several factors that are significant for achieving good tag retention:



Tag Positioning

- Black buttons (female part) must be positioned in the front of the ear, where they are protected by the curvature of the ear. This is also a "Health of Animals" requirement.
- Tag between the two main centre veins in the ear, in the first third of the ear next to the head
- To avoid infection, it is recommended that the application site be free of foreign debris prior to placement of tags on the animal
- Always dip tags in antiseptic solution prior to application
- When applying replacement tags, it is better to use a new hole

Take Your Time

More time and care taken with initial placement of tags is critical to long-term tag retention, appearance and program integrity.

Use a good applicator and pin

- Use the applicator recommended by the manufacturer – Red Allflex Universal Tagger – and make sure it is in good condition
- Remember that the **GREEN** pin must be used for Ultraflex dairy identifiers

Housing Environment

- Examine facilities carefully to look for catch areas
- Remove such hazards as nails, exposed metal sheeting, open-ended pipes, damaged feed troughs and bale string that can be tag traps



Taking extra care to ensure facilities remain animal-friendly helps to reduce tag loss.
