

proAction® Traceability 101

As you know, beginning September 2017, all Canadian dairy producers will need to meet both the Animal Care and Livestock Traceability requirements. That means starting in September; when farms are due for a Food Safety (CQM) validation, their compliance with Animal Care and Livestock Traceability requirements will be evaluated as well. The mandatory requirements related to Traceability are: Premises ID, animal ID, and animal movement.
